LOUISIANA	IDEA anticipates legislative activity in Louisiana in 2024.	Mar 11, 2024 – session convenes June 3, 2024 -- adjourns	iDEA will monitor the activity of the Louisiana Legislature. We are considering hiring a local lobbyist.
MARYLAND	Nov 15: The Maryland iGaming study detailing the impact iGaming could have on the state, has been completed and submitted to the Legislature. It is expected that the study results will help form the iGaming bill that is anticipated to be introduced in the MD Legislature in 2024. An overview/summary of the MD study can be found here .	Jan 10, 2024 – session convenes Apr 8, 2024 -- Adjourns	iDEA has retained a lobbying firm (Cornerstone) to help support our advocacy efforts in the state. They have strong relationships with key legislative stakeholders.
NEW HAMPSHIRE	Legislation passed the Senate in 2023, but stalled in the House. Senator Lang has stated his desire to move a “revised” bill in 2024. Based on intel received this week, it appears less likely that the Senator will pursue a bill in 2024. Because of procedural rules, he is unable to reintroduce the bill in his preferred form in this upcoming session. We are working to gather more info.	Jan 3, 2024 – session convenes Jun 28, 2024 – adjourns	iDEA is reaching out to Senator Lang to understand how he plans to proceed in 2024.
NEW JERSEY	IDEA continues to actively monitor the potential of a gaming tax increase and is working closely with various stakeholders. NJ’s Speaker of the House is considering a gaming tax increase. iDEA is actively working to persuade the Speaker otherwise. The New Jersey Gaming Association is also aware of what the Speaker is considering.		iDEA will monitor activity of the New Jersey Legislature.

OKLAHOMA	<p>OK Governor Kevin Stitt announced his proposal for sports betting. The proposal will have retail sports betting conducted by federally recognized Oklahoma tribes.</p> <p>The tax rate will be 15%. Tribal sports betting will be pursuant to a state-tribal gaming compact. Online sports betting will be offered by licensed sports betting operators.</p> <p>Operators would pay an initial licensing fee of \$500,000 and be required to pay an annual licensing fee of \$100,000. Of note, was the decision to remove restrictions on how affiliate marketers are compensated. A revised version of the rules have not yet been made available, but are expected soon. Please visit this website for the updated version.</p> <p>Further, the Commission is responding to numerous inquiries through its FAQ page, including much needed direction on what types of entities need to be licensed.</p> <p>14 companies have applied for operator licenses; 10 service providers; and 34 suppliers. They have not yet set a firm launch date, and plan to announce in the coming weeks.</p>	<p>Dec 27 – application submissions, for operators.</p>	<p>We are continuing to monitor the regulatory and licensing process. We anticipate that additional information impacting the market will be released in the coming weeks and we will analyze and share through the Portal.</p>
VERMONT <i>(Sports)</i>	<p>The Department of Liquor and Lottery selected DraftKings, FanDuel, and Fanatics Sportsbook to operate mobile sports betting platforms in Vermont.
